NTS is developing a "crosswalk" syllabus, under the NTS umbrella, which will meet the State 288-hour mandated curriculum. ETA: April 2018.

It teaches the theory and practical application of locks, door hardware and electronic access control systems. The course culminates in a system design exercise based on a customer's specifications and building plan.
